

PRESCRIPTIONS, MEDICINES AND TOILETRIES FROM GAIRLOCH PHARMACY

UPDATE – JAN 2021

Following the Government announcement that we are again in a National Lockdown, we can confirm we remain open our normal hours, and it's "business as before".

We are open 9.00am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday, and 9.00am to 1.00pm Saturday.

Collection of prescriptions, medicines, and other items from the pharmacy is allowed as "travel for essential purposes".

All prescriptions and medicines will need to be picked up from Gairloch Pharmacy.

As before, continue to order your medication from Aultbea or Gairloch Surgery as you normally do.

ALLOW AT LEAST 3 WORKING DAYS TO PROCESS THE REQUEST.

SATURDAY AND SUNDAY ARE NOT CLASSED AS WORKING DAYS

Collect from Gairloch Pharmacy yourself, or utilise family, friends, neighbours to collect on your behalf.

If this is still not possible, alternative arrangements are in place to help you – depending on where you live.

PLEASE NOTE – THIS IS NOT A REPLACEMENT DELIVERY SERVICE FOR ALL – IT IS FOR THOSE WHO CANNOT MAKE OTHER ARRANGEMENTS.

FOR THE AULTBEA, LAIDE AND SURROUNDING AREA ONLY – A ONCE A WEEK DELIVERY SERVICE WILL BE AVAILABLE – ON A THURSDAY.

Aultbea Community Council and Loch Ewe Community Church with the help of dedicated volunteers have made a pledge to continue a prescription delivery service locally for those who are unable to pick up their medications from Gairloch Pharmacy. This will operate once a week for folk in the Aultbea, Laide and surrounding area. **If you are unable to get to the pharmacy** and you are happy for a registered volunteer to pick up a prescription on your behalf please leave a message with Susan Maclean on 731539 by Wednesday 11am for delivery each Thursday. You still need to order your repeat prescription in the usual way through the surgery (allowing at least 3 working days for the prescription process - telephone order before Sunday for Thursday delivery)

Be smart, think ahead, streamline your household order at least a week in advance of your needs. We are here to help you.
